I fully understand that there is always an element of risk involved in anesthesia and/or surgery and knowing this, I hereby release Dr. Daniel Adcock, D.V.M. and staff from all liabilities in case of death, injury or complications to said patient while in their care.

PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOODWORK/IV FLUIDS/OTHER SERVICES

Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we prefer to perform a blood analysis. Blood chemistry tests give us an inside look at your pet's vital organs and let us know if they are functioning normally. Such tests are especially important before any kind of surgery. Our laboratory is fully equipped and staffed to perform these important blood tests today. Results will be available to review before anesthesia.

It is also in your pet's best interest to receive intravenous [I.V.] fluids during surgery. I.V. fluids help flush the animal's system of anesthesia and provides ready access for emergency medication should the need arise as well as help to maintain a healthy blood pressure.

Blood chemistry for pets less than 10 years of age [40.00]

Assure proper kidney and liver function which are vital to help metabolize the anesthesia properly.

Blood chemistry for sick pets or pets over 10 years of age [60.00]

Assure proper kidney and liver function which are vital to help metabolize the anesthesia properly. An aging pet's organs will gradually deteriorate, and may lose their ability to function properly. These tests give us a look at your pet's overall health status -- from liver function to cholesterol levels.
